

PARADISE LANES AUTUMN OPEN – GENERAL RULES

1. This is a scratch 5 Pin tournament open to all bowlers with or without an established average
2. ENTRY FEE is \$200.00. Cheques dated and received on or before October 1, 2009 will be accepted. After October 1, 2009 payment will ONLY be accepted as CASH. Please make cheques payable to "PARADISE LANES". Post dated or NSF cheques will nullify entry. In the unlikely event that the tournament is cancelled, all entry fees will be refunded.
3. The lane draw will be conducted under the supervision of the Tournament Committee. The following Shift Entry Cap's will be in place to ensure the tournament remains on schedule:
Fri. Noon – 54 entries, Sat. am – 54 entries, Sat. pm – 72 entries. Max entries = 180 players.
4. Prize money of \$24,000.00 is based on 125 minimum entries.
5. The tournament will consist of three 8-game qualifying shifts: (Friday Oct. 9 at 12:00 Noon and Saturday Oct. 10 at 8:30am and 2:30pm). Bowlers may enter all shifts but may only qualify once for the semi-final round of 40.
6. At the conclusion of the three qualifying shifts, the 40 bowlers with the highest pinfall will advance to the Semi-Final round. Those bowlers finishing 41st – 94th will be eligible to bowl in the Consolation Event Sunday Oct. 11 at 1:30pm.
7. The consolation event will consist of 3 games total pinfall. A \$20 side pot will be run.
8. The 40 semi-finalists will bowl 8 games Sunday Oct. 11 at 8:30am. The top 16 scores based on total pinfall will advance to the Finals Sunday Oct. 11 at 4:00pm.
9. The Finals will commence on Oct. 11 at 4:00pm. The 16 finalists will enter into a 15-game round robin match play event, where each bowler will bowl one game against each other Finalist. The winner will receive a 50-point bonus for each win. 25 points will be awarded to both players in the event of a tie. The total 15-game pinfall, plus all match play bonus points will determine 1st – 16th positions and prize money payouts.
10. In case of a tie for 40th place (in the qualifying rounds) or 16th place (in the semi-finals), one additional game will be bowled to break the tie. If there is a tie for 1st place in the finals, a two-game total pinfall tiebreaker will be bowled to determine the winner. For ties in any other positions, prize money will be split evenly.
11. The Tournament Committee will decide on any matters that may arise during the event, and their decision will be final.
12. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry before or during the tournament.
13. C5PBA Rules will be in effect for the Paradise Lanes Autumn Open.
14. Personalized bowling balls are allowed. C5PBA Sanction # M596-98-001. Paradise Lanes is NOT responsible for any damage incurred to personalized bowling balls during the event. Thumb Hole bowling balls will not be allowed during the event.
15. Bowlers Investment Seminar will be held immediately after the Saturday pm shift, approximately 9:00pm Saturday, Oct. 10th. (40 Players)

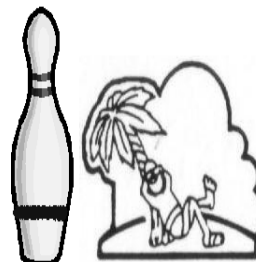

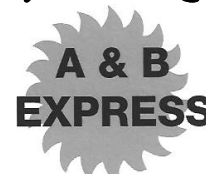
